SCHOLARSHIPS IN JAPAN 2023/2025

The Government of Japan is offering two-year scholarships to Maltese graduate students who wish to study at Japanese Universities as research students under the Japanese Government Scholarship Program for the academic years 2023-2025, in various subjects within the field of Culture, Sports, Science and Technology. Applicants must be willing to learn the Japanese language, interested in Japan and enthusiastic about deepening their understanding of Japan after arriving and capable of engaging in study and research while adapting themselves to life in Japan. Applicants are also required to contact a professor of the Japanese university where they wish to study and obtain a letter of acceptance.

All the required application documents should be submitted to the Embassy of Japan in Italy via email ryugaku@ro.mofa.go.jp. An online application form and copy of all documentation must also be submitted with the Ministry for Foreign And European Affairs and Trade, Malta on (https://www.servizz.gov.mt/en/Pages/Education_Science-and-Technology/Education-Services/Scholarships/WEB008/default.aspx).

The Embassy of Japan will select preliminary candidates among applicants by means of a review of the submitted documents, based on the academic background and research proposal, and on the basis of which it will organize for selected applicants a written test and interview for the final decision.

The deadline to submit all documentation is 20th May, 2022 at 8.00 a.m. (CET).

Late applications will not be considered.
