

Notice on Relocation and Disruption of Consular Services

The Embassy informs the public that due to the upcoming renovation works at the Embassy in Beijing that are expected to last 4 to 6 months, the Embassy will be relocated to the North Wing of the Delegation of the European Union in Beijing effective 22 September 2022.

During the initial phase of the relocation, 19-27 September 2022, disruptions may affect the Embassy's telephone lines including access to emails. For urgent matters only, the Embassy may be contacted on $+86\ 139\ 0101\ 7417$

With reference to visa and consular matters, the Embassy notes the following:

Passport Applications:

The Embassy will be unable to accept and process applications for new passports as well as passport renewals.

Visa Applications:

The Embassy will be unable to accept requests for visa applications directly through the mission.


The Embassy further informs that between 19 and 27 September 2022, the below mentioned Visa Application Centres will be temporary closed:

The Embassy confirms that this disruption will not affect Visa Application Centres in Shanghai, Hangzhou, and Nanjing under the jurisdiction of the Consulate General of Malta in Shanghai.

Visa Application Centres will resume normal operations effective 28 September 2022.
