

AGREEMENT

on the establishment of Diplomatic Relations
between Malta and the Republic of Belarus

Malta and the Republic of Belarus, guided by the desire to develop mutually beneficial relations between their countries and peoples in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations, the Final Act of the CSCE and the Charter of Paris for a new Europe, have agreed as follows:

Article 1

Malta and the Republic of Belarus have decided to establish diplomatic relations with each other and to exchange diplomatic representatives at Ambassadorial level.

Article 2

In their diplomatic and consular relations Malta and the Republic of Belarus will apply the provision of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18th April 1961 and will be guided by the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24th April 1963.

Article 3

This agreement enters into force upon signature.

Done in duplicate at Moscow on this 16th day of February 1993
in English and Belarussian, both texts being equally authentic.
