



PROTOCOL

On the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations Between the Republic of Malta and the Federated States of Micronesia

In order to develop their relations on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, the peaceful settlement of disputes with the purposes and principles established in the United Nations Charter, and with the relevant provisions of the 1961 Vienna Convention that regulates diplomatic relations between States.

The Republic of Malta and the Federated States of Micronesia have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ministerial level as from the date of this Protocol.

Both Parties have agreed that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 shall apply to diplomatic relations between them.

**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF MALTA
AND THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA**

The Government of the Republic of Malta and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia,

Desiring to promote and strengthen ties of friendship and cooperation between their countries and peoples on the basis of equality, mutual respect for each other's sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity as well as non-interference in the internal affairs of each other,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned Representatives, being duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in the English Language both texts being equally authentic.
