The Embassy of Malta presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan and has the honour to acknowledge receipt of the latter's Note Verbale Nº 176/13 dated 13th October 1994, concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between Malta and the Republic of Azerbaijan.

The Embassy of Malta wishes to inform that the Government of Malta

-Being guided by the aims and principles of the United Nation's Charter, being based upon the Helsinki Final Act, the Paris Charter for a new Europe, the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18th, 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of April 24th, 1963,

-Being desirous to widen further relations and strengthen the co-operation between the two countries, based with confidence on principles of mutual respect for sovereign equality, territorial integrity, inviolability of frontiers, non-interference in the internal affairs of each other and other general recognised principles of International Law,

-Being considerate that the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries will create the favourable conditions for the fruitful and mutually beneficial co-operation and will influence to strengthen in the political, economic, trade and cultural fields,

-Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at the level of Embassies.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malta is in full accord that Note Verbale № 176/13 dated 13th October 1994 from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan and this Note Verbale № 71/94 from the Embassy of Malta constitute an agreement for the establishment of diplomatic relations which are set up as from date of this Note Verbale.

The Embassy of Malta avails itself of the opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan the assurances of its highest consideration.
