## P R O T O C O L

on the establishment of diplomatic relations  
between Malta and the Republic of Georgia

The Government of Malta and the Government of the Republic of Georgia, guided by their common will to develop relations of friendship and co-operation in the political, economic, commercial, humanitarian and other fields, reconfirm their decision to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level.

While expressing the satisfaction for the important evolution in their relations, the two Parties undertake to develop them further on the basis of the principles of sovereignty, equality, mutual respect, territorial integrity and non-interference in internal affairs in accordance with the UN Charter, the Helsinki Final Act, the Paris Charter for a New Europe and other CSCE Documents, and guided by the Vienna Conventions on Diplomatic and Consular relations adopted on April 18, 1961, and on April 24, 1963.

The two Parties are convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between Malta and the Republic of Georgia corresponds to the national interests of both States, and will promote the strengthening of international co-operation and universal peace.

This protocol enters into force upon signature.
