



## JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MALTA AND THE COOK ISLANDS

The Government of the Republic of Malta and the Government of the Cook Islands,

Desirous to promote and strengthen ties of friendship, peaceful existence and co-operation between their countries in the political, economic and cultural fields, on the basis of equality, mutual respect for independence and sovereignty, and non-interference in each other's internal affairs.

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as the Vienna convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 1963;

Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Republic of Malta and the Cook Islands corresponds with interests of the Two States and will facilitate the strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace;

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.
