



## PROTOCOL

On the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between  
Malta  
and the Kingdom of Lesotho.

The Governments of Malta and the Kingdom of Lesotho, desiring to develop relations of friendship and co-operation in the political, economic, commercial, humanitarian and other fields, have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at High Commissioner level.

The two Parties undertake to further develop their relations on the basis of the principles of sovereignty, equality, mutual respect, territorial integrity and non-interference in internal affairs in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations, and guided by the spirit of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations adopted on the 18th April, 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations adopted on the 24th April, 1963.

The two Parties are convinced that the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Malta and the Kingdom of Lesotho conforms with the national interests of both states, and will promote the strengthening of international co-operation and universal peace.

This protocol enters into force upon signature.
