



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**THE MEDITERRANEAN ACADEMY OF DIPLOMATIC STUDIES
OF THE REPUBLIC OF MALTA**

AND

**THE FOREIGN SERVICE ACADEMY OF THE
MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF
BANGLADESH**

The Mediterranean Academy of Diplomatic Studies, located in Malta and the Foreign Service Academy of Bangladesh (hereinafter referred to as "the Participants");

RECOGNIZING the spirit of cooperation that exists between the Republic of Malta and the People's Republic of Bangladesh and WILLING to promote closer collaboration in the training of diplomats and related fields;

Have jointly reached the following understandings:

Paragraph 1

Purpose

1.1 The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to promote regular contact and cooperation between the Participants.

Paragraph 2

Cooperation

2.1 The Participants will cooperate in the exchange of information and experiences concerning their respective programs of study and research, seminars and other academic and training activities.

2.2 The Participants may explore the possibilities of other forms of cooperation within the scope of objectives of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Paragraph 3

Issues of Mutual Concern

3.1 The Participants will explore the possibility of exchanges of trainees, faculty members, experts and researchers.

3.2 The Participants will encourage cooperation in the fields of study and research, as well as in exchanging information on national and international publications, especially in areas of mutual interest.

Paragraph 4

Exchange of Information

4.1 The Participants will exchange information and views related to international trends and advances in training and research in diplomacy, foreign policy, international relations, international law, foreign economic relations, political science and other relevant areas.

Paragraph 5

Projects and Finance

5.1 The Participants will conclude separate Protocol(s) laying down the terms and conditions of any project(s) approved jointly.



5.2 The forms, duration and financial arrangements of any project(s), decided upon in the context of this MoU shall be subject to prior mutual consent in writing, of the Participants of this MoU.

Paragraph 6

Settlement of Disputes and Amendments

6.1 Any disagreement(s) regarding the interpretation or application of this MoU will be settled amicably through mutual consultation or negotiation between the Participants.

6.2 Provisions of this MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the Participants.

Paragraph 7

Coming into Effect

7.1 This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of its signing and will continue to have effect for a period of three years. Thereafter, it may automatically be renewed for equal periods of time, unless terminated by either of the Participants by giving a written notice of ninety (90) days to the other Participant prior to the date of termination of the MoU.

7.2 The termination of this Memorandum of Understanding will not affect other ongoing projects between the two Participants /States.
