

PROTOCOL

on the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Malta and the Republic of Montenegro

In order to develop their relations on the basis of the principles of equality of states, mutual respect, self-determination, independence and sovereignty, territorial integrity, non-interference in internal affairs and peaceful solution of international controversies according to the United Nations Charter,

Malta and the Republic of Montenegro have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level as from the date of this Protocol.

Both parties have agreed that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 shall apply to diplomatic relations between them.

Both parties have also agreed that, pending the conclusion of new agreements, the former agreements concluded between Malta and the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, shall remain applicable between Malta and the Republic of Montenegro.

Signed in Vienna on the 15th July, 2006.
