



PROTOCOL

On the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between
Malta
and the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis

The Government of Malta and the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis, desirous to develop relations of friendship and co-operations in the political, economic, commercial, humanitarian and other fields, have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at High Commissioner level.

The two Parties undertake to develop further their relations on the basis of the principles of sovereignty, equality, mutual respect, territorial integrity and non-interference in internal affairs in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations, and guided by the spirit of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic and Consular relations adopted in April 18, 1961 and on April 24, 1963.

The two Parties are convinced that the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Malta and the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis conforms with the national interests of both States, and will promote the strengthening of international co-operation and universal peace.

This protocol enters into force upon signature.

The two Parties are convinced that the establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis and Malta conforms with national interests of both States, and will promote the strengthening of international co-operation and universal peace.
