

**PROTOCOL EXTENDING THE VALIDITY OF THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SWISS CONFEDERATION AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF MALTA REGARDING THE MEDITERRANEAN
ACADEMY OF DIPLOMATIC STUDIES, OF JULY 12, 1990**

The Swiss Government and the Government of Malta

HAVING REVIEWED the functioning of the Mediterranean Academy of Diplomatic Studies, set up under the Agreement of July 12, 1990;

NOTING that in conformity with Article 1 of the said Agreement the Government of Malta signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the United Nations Environment Programme on the establishment of a UNEP Chair of Environmental Diplomacy and a Letter of Intent with the Government of Tunisia on the association of Tunisia with the Academy, and that discussions are under way with other Governments and institutions with a view to obtaining their association with the Academy;

IN VIEW OF the reorganisation of the modalities of Swiss support to regional diplomatic training programmes, as a result of which this support will be administered in future by the Graduate Institute of International Studies in Geneva on behalf of the Swiss Directorate of Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Aid;

AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Swiss contribution to the Academy for the triennium 1993-1996 and any further periods that may be agreed on shall be defined by an exchange of letters between the Graduate Institute of International Studies and the Mediterranean Academy of Diplomatic Studies. This provision replaces Article 3 of the Agreement of July 12, 1990 and the Special Agreement between the University of Malta and the Graduate Institute of International Studies.
2. As regards the annual financial contribution of the Government of Malta according to Article, 2 (2.1.) of the Agreement of July 12, 1990, it shall be raised from Lm10,000 to Lm15,000 as from January 1st, 1994.
3. In the interest of the admission of as many junior diplomats from Mediterranean countries in particular need of assistance, the Government of Malta shall recommend to the University of Malta to reduce University fees for the holders of Swiss scholarships for the Master in Diplomacy.
4. In March 1996, the performance of the Academy shall be evaluated by a joint commission whose precise composition shall be determined by consultation among all interested parties.

5. This Protocol is an integral part of the Agreement between the Governments of Malta and Switzerland, which shall remain in force indefinitely. It may be terminated by agreement between the parties or by one party notifying the other of its desire to terminate it. Such notification must be made at the beginning of an academic year and shall take effect at the end of the academic year.
