



## JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

### ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN MALTA AND THE REPUBLIC OF TOGO

The Government of Malta and the Government of the Republic of Togo,

Guided by their mutual willingness to develop and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two States in the political, social, economic and cultural fields in accordance with the principles and norms enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961 and the universally recognized principles of international law,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

The Government of Malta and the Government of the Republic of Togo wish to express their mutual confidence that establishing diplomatic relations correspond to the interests of both States and will help to consolidate international Peace and Security as well as the peaceful co-existence.


