

P R O T O C O L

on the establishment of diplomatic relations
between Malta and Ukraine

Malta and Ukraine,

Guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of partnership and cooperation in political, trade, economic, cultural, humanitarian and other fields,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of signing this Protocol and to exchange diplomatic missions at the level of embassies.


The Sides have decided to base their relations in this respect on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations adopted on 18 April, 1961.

The Sides have reached an agreement to develop their relations on the basis of principles of sovereign equality, mutual respect, territorial integrity and non-interference in the domestic affairs of each other in accordance with the UN Charter, provisions of the Helsinki Final Act, Paris Charter for new Europe and other CSCE documents.

The Sides are confident that the establishment of diplomatic relations between Malta and Ukraine corresponds to the national interests of both States and will facilitate the strengthening on international cooperation and universal peace.

Done in Kiev on March "5", 1992, in duplicate in the English and Ukrainian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
